

## **LOCKWOOD MEMORIAL FIELD**

### **OFF-LEASH DOG PARK RULES**

The fenced in area of the baseball diamond at Lockwood Memorial Field has been designated as an OFF-LEASH DOG PARK for the period of November 1, 2015 - April 30, 2016 according to By-law 15-13. All dog handlers using the fenced in specified area of the park must adhere to the following PARK RULES:

1. Dogs must be vaccinated, licensed and in good health
2. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult; and kept under strict supervision at all times
3. Dogs must be on a leash while entering and exiting the baseball diamond
4. Do NOT allow children to run in the area or chase after dogs
5. Owners/handlers must remain in the baseball diamond with the dog and carry a leash.
6. Aggressive dogs shall not be permitted to use the park. Persistent aggressive behaviour by dogs or handlers will not be tolerated. Both the handler and dog(s) will be asked to leave and privileges will be suspended
7. Dogs in heat or coming into heat are not allowed in the dog park
8. Owners/Handlers must pick up after their dogs and dispose of waste in the designated containers
9. Toys, glass containers and food (human or canine) are not permitted in the dog park
10. Respect the rights of others
11. Smoking is not permitted within the fenced dog park
12. No Pit Bulls or Pit Bull cross dogs are allowed in the park, unless permitted under the Dog Owners Liability Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter D.16 (DOLA)
13. Professional dog trainers are not permitted to use the off-leash areas to conduct their business
